### Poster Session Guidelines

Due to overwhelming requests, we are happy to announce that AFE will again accept a limited number of Poster Session projects this year!

We invite interested agencies, Tribal governments, organizations, researchers, as well as individual participants to submit their projects to be displayed at the Alaska Forum on the Environment (AFE). Projects should be current, applicable to AFE and may include photographs, literature, and summary information (no “props” please) on poster board. Suggested topics include: community recycling projects, innovative clean up projects, invasive species, climate change research, emergency response, environmental regulations, fish and wildlife populations, rural issues, energy, military issues, pollution prevention, and contaminants. Agencies or organizations submitting a Poster Session project must provide a written description of the project in the submission form. A location will be identified for your poster project to be displayed throughout the week. AFE must receive your project idea submission by close of business, **January 31, 2012**, in order for it to be reviewed. We will be **accepting up to 20 submissions** this year. #### Selection Process

AFE seeks creative, innovative work that compliments the Forum. All entries will be reviewed for originality, quality, content and support of conference themes.

#### Notification

Poster projects selected for displays will be notified no later than February 1, 2012.

#### Poster Display Details and Timeframe

Poster session projects must be dropped off at the Registration desk at the Dena'ina Convention Center Monday morning between 7–11 AM. Posters will be displayed by AFE volunteer staff by Monday afternoon. All poster projects can be displayed through 12 Noon on Thursday, February 9, 2012

All Poster Session projects must be wall mountable. AFE Staff will be placing Velcro or clipping posters with a device to attach it to the wall. This should not compromise the quality of the poster. We ask that conference participants not put tack or nails holes in the walls.
