Registration and conference fees for up to 3 representatives and an adult partner will be reduced or waived and conference mentors will assist when needed with locating travel and lodging funds and preparing presentations and visual aids.

Selected projects will represent a broad scope of issues and various roles for youth and their adult partners. Representatives will include at least one adult partner – who must also be a part of or advisor to the project.
